NOTE: No more than 8 units of Political Science courses numbered 190 or above will apply to the major. Further, no more than 4 units each in any of the following may be included in these 8 allowable units of 190 series courses 190, 192, 193, 194, 199. In exceptional cases, up to 4 UD units in a related field may be substituted by petition to the undergraduate advisor.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Not allowed for any major courses, including courses applied to the major from other departments, with one exception: Up to 4 units of Pol S 192 (P/NP required) may be applied to the major.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major, including courses in excess of minimum requirements.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
